

Victims' Rights during Sentencing:

You have the right:

- To provide the pre-sentence investigator with information regarding the emotional, physical, and financial impact the crime has had on you.
- To provide tell the pre-sentence investigator your sentencing recommendations (with limitations in Death Penalty Cases)
- To have a copy of the pre-sentence report, upon request, when it is available to the defendant
- To be heard at the time of sentencing, and to present evidence at any aggravation, mitigation, pre-sentencing or sentencing proceeding (with limitations in Death Penalty Cases)
- To have the court order the defendant to pay restitution for your economic losses directly related to the crime
- To exercise your right to be heard in any proceeding by providing an oral, written or video/audio taped statement
- To be provided a "Post-Conviction Request Form" to request your rights to post-conviction notification
